



# PONY \_ **EXPRESS** Capital of Nebraska

othenburg is home to two Pony Express Stations. The Midway Station, on its original ranch site south of Gothenburg, is open to the public upon request during the summer.


The Sam Machette Station, located in Ehmen Park at 15th Street and Lake Avenue, was originally erected in 1854 on the Oregon Trail west of Gothenburg near Fort McPherson. At that time, it was used as a fur trading post and ranch house. Later, from 1860 to 1861, the structure was used as a Pony Express Station.

In 1931, the building was dismantled log by log and moved from its original site. It was

rebuilt in the park to preserve it for future generations to enjoy.

The Pony Express Station & Museum became a public gift shop and museum in 1954 and has welcomed thousands of visitors annually ever since. A guide shares the story of the brave riders who carried mail 2,000 miles between St. Joseph, Missouri, and Sacramento, California, between April 1860 and October 1861. During the off-season, visitors can listen to the story via a 24/7 FM radio broadcast outside the station.

In August 1992, the Nebraska Legislature voted to officially name Gothenburg the Pony Express Capital of Nebraska. The Pony Express continues to be a consistent theme throughout the community.





**Approximately** 25,000 people visit inside the Pony Express Station & Museum every year. Another 10,000 to 15,000 stop during the off season or after hours.



The main north-south street and business district of Gothenburg was originally called Winchell Street, named after one of the first families to settle here. It was renamed Lake Avenue in 1920.

Businesses were plenty in 1910 and covered a variety of products, including the Gem Theatre, Colloms Cafe and Jennings Hardware.



# RICH HISTORY

Union Pacific accepted the section of railroad through Gothenburg in November 1866. The town was platted by UP in 1882.



There were so many people in the business district along Winchell Street (now Lake Avenue) there must have been a special event.



n the latter part of 1882, a worker with the Union Pacific Railroad named Olof Bergstrom conceived the idea that a town was needed where Gothenburg now stands. The town is situated in the Platte River Valley, which is one of the greatest agricultural valleys in the world.

Bergstrom chose farm ground north of the town site and traveled back to Sweden to convince his fellow countrymen to migrate to the United States — to Nebraska — to build a new town in the West. He was persuasive and by July 8, 1885, Gothenburg was incorporated as a town with a population of 300.

# Ancestors' tradition of vision & hope continue

Swedes and Germans settled the area, as is evidenced by the name Gothenburg. The town was named after Göteborg, Sweden, but was given a German spelling by railroad officials.

The digging of a 12-mile canal off the Platte River and construction of the first man-made lake designed to generate electricity encouraged several industries and factories to locate in Gothenburg. Companies included shirt and overall factories, brick kilns, bathtub and ironworks factories, flour mills, vinegar and pickle works, a cigar manufacturer and a barbed wire factory.

The boom days came early in the 1890s. Then, when the money panic of 1893 hit hard, the boom quickly turned to bust and many of the industries disappeared. Despite the loss of business, the canal provided the first irrigation system and served approximately 17,000 acres east of the lake. Agriculture quickly settled in as the main industry for the growing community, and agriculture continues to drive our prosperity today.

The man-made lake spurred industrial, community and agricultural growth, a hallmark of Gothenburg's success throughout its history.

Most Gothenburg residents had electricity by 1892, the first connected community in western Nebraska.

Community volunteers cleared land, planted trees and erected buildings to develop a park area adjacent to the lake in the early 1900s, calling it Lafayette Park. With the help of many

organizations and residents, the lake and park represent the ingenuity and tenacity of our city's volunteers.

Lake Helen's impact on Gothenburg's early industrial history

and on its agricultural and recreational development over more than a century ago helped Gothenburg earn the Nebraska Community Improvement Program's Community of the Century in 2000. Lake Helen received the acclaim of Project of the Century that same



year. In more recent years, Lake Helen got another face lift that included draining, dredging and an all-out overhaul thanks to a variety of grants and city funds. Officials continue to improve the area.

Gothenburg's founder literally led Swedish immigrants to his proposed town site and asked them to make his vision a reality. Community leaders continue to have a vision for the future, working to make Gothenburg a place where people feel comfortable raising their families and settling in for retirement. Olof

# IF WALLS COULD TALK

### Majestic old homes welcome new construction

ell preserved Victorians, compact bungalows, contemporary ranch-style homes and stately twostory estates are graciously blended throughout Gothenburg's residential areas.

Most homes close to the downtown district and along Lake Avenue — one of the most beautiful "main streets" in America — are 80+ years old. The Chamber of Commerce offers a walking tour of the historic homes, guided by a brochure or the QR code here. The growth in Gothenburg has been mainly to the north and northeast, in addition to the new houses built around Wild Horse Golf Club north and west of town.

Home prices range from \$80,000 to \$500,000, although most are priced \$150,000 to \$300,000. They vary in age from brand new to century-



old treasures that hold a place on the National Historic Register.

A few vacant lots interspersed throughout town are available to build on with land for new construction still available around Wild Horse Golf Club.

The northeast part of town is the latest to be developed. A concerted effort began with the construction of several spec homes in 2015 that were all sold prior to completion. Six more were done in 2020. City leaders continue to work diligently to provide more housing units so Gothenburg can keep growing.

The most recent project — driven by Rural Workforce Housing Funds — includes nearly 20 single-family homes built in three separate subdivisions. Three semi-custom homes have also been built in the northeast part of town, serving as the anchor to a large new subdivision that will allow for further growth and development.



# WHILE YOU'RE HERE

hether you are visiting for an afternoon or plan to spend the rest of your life, there's plenty to occupy your spare time in Gothenburg.


Those with an active lifestyle can enjoy a variety of sports and outdoor leisure activities as recreation opportunities abound. Whether it's a mountain bike ride in the hills, a round of disc golf in the park or reeling in a big fish, we've got you covered.

Lake Helen was created in the early 1890s when a 12-mile canal was dug to allow water from the Platte River to fill a dammed canyon and create a reservoir. Originally, the lake was used to generate electricity that brought industry to

the area. Now it provides a scenic recreation area that is excellent for fishing and it also features a 2.5-mile exercise trail and disc golf course.

Across the covered bridge to the north of Lake Helen, Lafayette Park provides a well-shaded camping area with pads for campers and primitive spots for tents. The horseshoe pits offer the perfect setting for a friendly competition.

Besides tubing and canoeing on the Platte River, other water sports are popular at close-by reservoirs. Jeffrey, Midway and Johnson Lakes — each about 20 minutes from Gothenburg — provide the perfect setting to fill summer days with fun with sailing, power boating, water skiing and fishing.





### It's a small town but that doesn't mean there's nothing to do

Some of the best mountain bike trails in Nebraska can be found near Jeffrey Lake. Potter's Pasture consists of close to 100 miles of trails through 1,200 acres of hills and canyons. The area is privately owned but free and open to the public, including the campgrounds.

If you're headed west to Jeffrey Lake or Potter's Pasture, don't miss out on the fabulous wine and pizza at the Old Depot Vineyard and Winery just 12 miles west on Banner Road. Winery owners moved the old Gothenburg depot that was set for demolition and re-purposed it. Inside, you can still feel the dip in the floor where many boots stood at the ticket window.

History buffs can take a peek into Gothenburg's past inside the Pony Express Station & Museum and our Gothenburg Historical Museum. The Pony Express Station & Museum sits in the middle of Ehmen Park. which is an affiliate of the Nebraska Statewide Arboretum. There are 111 trees representing 62 varieties in the park. Across the street, the Gothenburg Historical Museum offers displays of the country's expansion westward as German and Swedish settlers brought businesses and families to live in this fledgling community. The museum is open May through September.

More history is on display in the Swedish Crosses Cemetery north of town, where three markers have stood for over a century. These artistic crosses, wrought in Swedish steel by a loving grandfather, mark the graves of three children who died on their prairie homestead.

The Sod House Museum was built as a memorial to the first settlers of the area. The grounds feature a barn, sod house replica, windmill and life-sized barbed wire sculptures. The museum is open when weather permits.



### Discover adventure at **SMILIN**

# RANCH

ust south of I-80 in rural Gothenburg, nestled in the heart of the Platte River valley, sits a ranch that hearkens back to the old west. Along the Oregon Trail and Pony Express routes, Smilin' Ranch Adventures offers tourists and locals a taste of the true western lifestyle, complete with horseback riding, cattle drives, ranch camps and more. Here, you can press pause on the fast pace of modern life and experience a trip back to yesteryear on a real working ranch.

Follow along with hosts Ty and Malloree Barnes on a typical day-in-the-life of a cowboy. Immerse yourself in feeding the animals, helping with ranch chores, exploring gargeous pastureland, horse riding, wagon rides, campfires and caring for a cattle herd.

Don't have time for a full adventure? Stop by the Pony Express Station in town for a horsedrawn wagon ride and learn about the history of some of Gothenburg's oldest homes and town founders.

Or, swing out to the ranch to visit the Milk House, a raw milk dairy featuring milking tours, raw milk products and educational opportunities. You could

even try your hand at milking as you learn about the health benefits of unpasteurized, non-homogenized, natural milk.

Camper hookups are available or there's a camper to rent during your stay, as well as a horse hotel and riding arena for equestrian guests. Scan the QR code to learn more and book your adventure.

"Our passion at Smilin' Ranch Adventures is to involve people in every way and not only show them our way of life, but get them right in the middle of it so they can see why we do what we do," says Malloree Barnes.

# WORLD-CLASS EVERYWHERE YOU LOOK

### It's an "all-means-all" attitude

othenburg residents have a history of going the extra mile to ensure the community remains a top-notch city that sets the standard for others.

From city services and health care to recreation and early childhood learning, joining forces is what we do in Gothenburg. It is our all-means-all attitude that led to Gothenburg receiving national recognition as an All-America City — twice. And it is citywide teamwork that keeps our proud and progressive community pushing forward.

The city is led by an elected mayor and four city council members. A city administrator manages the day-to-day operations and guides projects such as adding a solar array to reduce electric rates, renovating city parks, applying for grant funds and improving streets and sidewalks.

Some of the city's excellent facilities include the public library, senior center, swimming

pool and four-plex ball fields. Two new park playgrounds and a splash pad will become operational in 2024.

The city also boasts an outstanding fire department. The 44-person squad of allvolunteer firemen manage a six-bay facility. More than half of the volunteers are EMTs, and the average response time is 2.3 minutes.

The city works closely with Gothenburg Improvement Company, a nonprofit established in 1961. GIC plays a vital role in securing the city's future, and the primary goal of this volunteer organization is to improve and preserve a great quality of life through economic development.

The YMCA at Gothenburg Health is one of the latest examples of GIC's collaborative work to better our city. The expanded wellness center began as a shared vision that included community, education, recreation and



wellness. Through cooperation between many Gothenburg entities, the city was able to secure a partnership with the YMCA of the Prairie and our YMCA opened in 2018.

That medically integrated YMCA facility would not have been possible without collaboration

from Gothenburg Health, which provides critical access services to our region. The hospital has expanded to become a leader among smaller hospitals in the state. It includes a physician clinic, advanced imaging department, patient wing, emergency department and state-of-the-art surgical suite. The hospital and clinic offer family practitioners, mid-level providers and multiple visiting specialists.

In addition to Gothenburg Health, the community also supports three dentists, three chiropractors, a cash-based medical clinic and one optometrist.

A current collaborative effort will result in the Impact Center, set to open in the fall of 2024. The Impact Center is an integrated facility that will have four elements: an early learning center, a healthy families center, a sports training center and an event center. Grant funds and local financial support are bringing to life this gamechanger for our community.

And we would be remiss if we didn't count Wild Horse Golf Club among our city's world-

class offerings. Amateur or pro, you'll want to play our nationally ranked 18-hole public course.

Each year, the course receives high acclaim from golf reviewers and enthusiasts from around the world. Most recently, Wild Horse was rated the No. 3 best public course in Nebraska by



Golf Digest and Golf Week, as well as the No. 5 best course you can play in the U.S for under \$150 by Golf.com.

Wild Horse Golf Club includes a clubhouse with snack bar and pro shop, practice area with driving range and chipping green, and a staff that promises an exceptional experience. There are two cabins on site with four bedrooms each, private baths, kitchenette and fabulous patio so you can stay-and-play.

There is so much we could brag about in Gothenburg. These examples are just a small part of the "Gothenburg Way" that sets our city apart.

### GHS student produces

## HISTORICAL AUDIO TOUR

othenburg Historical Audio Tour began about three years ago when Gothenburg High School student Avery Salomon was in eighth grade. With her freshmen year fast approaching, she says she had no idea what she was going to do for her FFA project.

Since most ag-related activities were foreign to Avery, she knew she wanted to do something different than her classmates, something that involved the community.

Avery's mother, Niki, suggested that she could educate visitors about historical and agricultural locations in Gothenburg. Avery says honestly, she wasn't exactly open to the idea at first but eventually came around.

Currently, the audio tour features seven episodes, with more to be added in the summer of 2024. Each video can be found on the YouTube channel and Facebook page, both titled "Gothenburg Historical Audio Tour"



Signage at each location provides a QR code for easy access.

On the social media pages, visitors can find all seven episodes, each featuring a different historical topic or location along with audio from Gothenburg native and history enthusiast Mark Peyton.

"Mr. Peyton has been an instrumental part of the project since the beginning, and I am so grateful for his help in voicing this podcast and researching information," Avery says.


Completed episodes feature: Frito Lay, Gothenburg Public Library,

Pony Express Chevrolet Buick recently celebrated 30 years of selling vehicles in Gothenburg. The auto dealer contributes an extraordinary amount of sales tax to the city's budget.

Another longtime family-owned operation is Gothenburg Feed Products, an alfalfa dehydrating business over 75 years in production. The plant provides alfalfa feed pellets across the country.
